

**Quick Start Guide for Setting up Integration
between Eventsential and Conferences i/o**

Overview

Eventsential offers a wonderful integration with Conferences i/o. This integration allows you to focus your efforts on creating your sessions and speakers in Eventsential, and then with a few clicks of the mouse, those same sessions and speakers get created in Conferences i/o.

You can also quickly choose which sessions will feature the option for your attendees to use Q&A/Polling and/or to Evaluate the Session.



Eventsential integration – Click on Setup

From the [Event details page](#), under the Event Info tab, click the Setup button to the right of the Engagement Tools Integration choice.



Eventsential integration – Enter the URI

Enter the Conferences i/o App URI, not including the ".cnf.io".

For example, if your URL was acmeconf.cnf.io, enter just **acmeconf**


Eventsential integration – Step #1 (Import)

Click the **Synchronize** button. Doing so will ‘push’ your sessions and presenter names over (into) Conferences i/o.

We’ll skip “Step 2” on the screen.

At the bottom of the screen (“Step 3”), visit the “Click here” link to choose which sessions will feature access to Q&A/Polling and/or Evaluations.

IMPORTANT: After adding or changing any sessions or speakers in Eventsential, click this Synchronize button again to push those changes into Conferences i/o.
